

## Eligibility Criteria

### Minimum Academic Qualifications for B.Arch:

- Passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with at least 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics and also at least 50% marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination (OR) Passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate.
- Merit list shall be based on aggregate marks of 10+2 and valid NATA score (percentage) or score (percentage) of qualified JEE (Main) Paper-2 -2019 (B. Arch./B.Planning) in the ratio 50:50.
- The candidate must have passed NATA with valid NATA Score as per COA.
- Obtained at least 50% marks (47.5% in case of candidate belonging to SC category) in the qualifying Examination.

NOTE: "No candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless she/ he has passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with at least 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics and also at least 50% marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination (OR) Passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate".
